













STORYCENTER STYLE


- 1.Self-revelatory
- 2. Personal or first person voice
- 3. Lived experience (Specific)
- 4.Photos more than moving image: Still images in small numbers create a relaxed visual pace against the narration.
- 5.Soundtrack
- 6.Length and Design: The ideal length is 2-3 minutes, with a minimal use of features available in digital video editors to create a raw, more direct feel.
- 7.Intention: Self-expression and self-awareness are valued.







an interactive (non)fiction about living with depression You have to be awake for work in a mere 8 hours, and you know that your work is so much worse on only a few hours sleep.


What do you do?

- 6: Go to your computer. Sleep is clearly not happening no matter how long you lay here.









Nonlinear timeline-based video editing software



Digital audio workstation for multitrack recording, editing, and mixing



 - ➤ Create Final Piece




PROCESS
